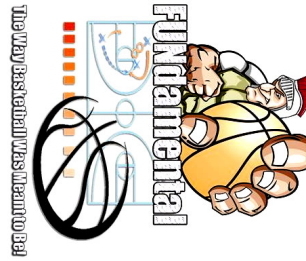
## PLEASE NOTE:

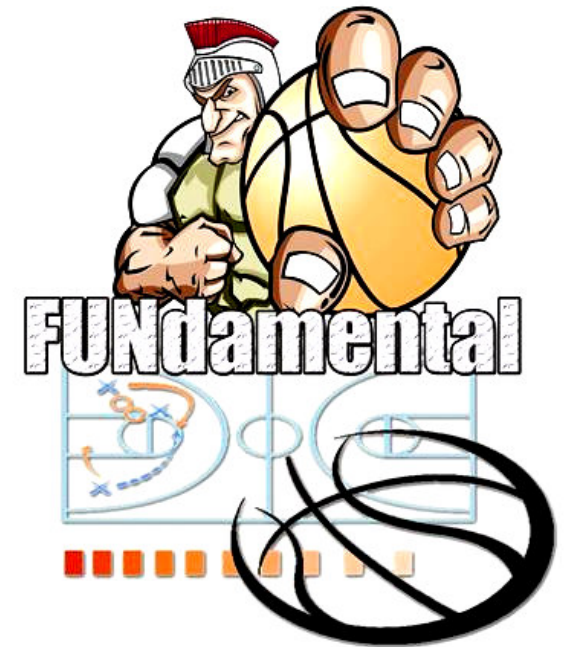
