



DISCIPLINE POLICY AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM

1. Self-discipline is the goal that Wayne Country Day teachers and staff have set for themselves and their students. This can be achieved through cooperation among all parties involved – students, teachers, staff, and parents. Communication is one of the keys; we will be in touch with parents, and we expect parents to be in touch with us if a problem or a potential problem arises.
2. Positive reinforcement of appropriate behavior is emphasized. Praise and other tangible methods of reinforcement for each individual student are used as often as possible.
3. No student shall be subjected to any form of corporal punishment by any staff person.
4. No student shall be handled roughly in any way, including shaking, pushing, shoving, pinching, slapping, kicking, or spanking.
5. No student shall ever be placed in a locked room or closet.
6. No discipline shall ever be delegated to another child.
7. No food shall be withheld, or given, as a means of discipline.
8. No student shall ever be disciplined for lapses in toilet training.
9. No student shall ever be disciplined for not sleeping during rest period.
10. No student will be given any medication without parental permission.
